ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES

- Region 2 (Worksource Portland Metro) is working with the City of Portland to list Stimulus jobs. The City anticipates granting ARRA funds in October 2009.
- Several regions are working with WIA/1B providers: Region 4 (Lincoln County) is working with Community Services Consortium to place 75 youth on forest crews performing tasks such as trail and stream restoration, historic site restoration. Region 15 (Clackamas county) is listing youth internship/job shadow jobs
- Region 5 (Lane county) will be getting weatherization listings from Housing and Community Services.
- Region 10 (Deschutes, Jefferson, Crook counties) is listing ARRA jobs such as Housing counseling assistant, and several Teacher assistant positions for Head Start
- Region 13 (Union, Wallowa, Baker county) is contacting local ODOT contractors who have been awarded Stimulus contracts to assist with recruitment. Wallowa-Whitman National Forest in Baker City will receive \$5M in Stimulus funds for trail maintenance. The OED Employer representative will be assisting with recruitment efforts.

UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- Competitive federal grant through ARRA to obtain funding to upgrade Business & Employment Services field office broadband capabilities. The notice of funds availability was just announced on July 1, with grant application due August 14. Letter to Legislative leadership sent July 31.
- Region 10 and their Local Workforce Investment Board will be working with our Research section to apply for an ARRA green jobs grant specific to labor market information. The program would collect additional skills data through the Career Readiness Certification program which will enhance our understanding of the foundational skills and tasks required for green jobs. Grant application deadline is August 14. Letter to Legislative leadership sent July 31.



EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT (CONTINUED)

- The Oregon Workforce Investment Board (OWIB) is planning to pursue a State Energy Sector Partnership grant (one of the green jobs grants from DOL). Discussions are underway to integrate current activities into the proposal, and to make the grant seamless with the Green Jobs Strategy the Legislature recently required from OWIB. The grant application is due October 20.
