## ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES

- There are currently 72 petitions pending for Oregon for firms that hope to receive Trade Act benefits for their separated workers. To date, 4 firms have received certification. In the past few weeks, Symantec (Springfield software company) and RadiSys (Hillsboro embedded computer manufacturer) have received certification. Both firms qualified as a result of activities moving offshore.
- The McMinnville Worksource Oregon office reports they are working with a local manufacturer to fill OJT positions partially funded with Stimulus funds.
- The Redmond office has several listings for NeighborImpact related to energy assistance waiting to be filled, which are awaiting receipt of Stimulus funds.
- The Clackamas Worksource Oregon office has worked jointly with Clackamas Community College to fill 30 slots in the material handler training. The training began this week.

## UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- The Oregon Workforce Investment Board (OWIB) is planning to pursue a State Energy Sector Partnership grant (one of the green jobs grants from DOL). Discussions are underway to integrate current activities into the proposal, and to make the grant seamless with the Green Jobs Strategy the Legislature recently required from OWIB. The grant application is due October 20.
