ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES

- Claimant Reemployment sessions around the state are active, and staff in some regions are following up with phone calls to offer assistance and let claimants know about available resources. The Gresham CRE sessions are open to all job seekers and last week 23 walk-ins attended as well as those scheduled. There is a definite need in the community for these services.
- Recent Trade Act activity shows an increase over the past three months, with 27 new certifications, 4 denials, and 7 investigations terminated prior to a final determination. Each certification provides scores of workers with generous Trade Act benefits to enable them to retrain for new careers and additional benefits to tide them over after their unemployment claim is exhausted.
- Of those firms certified, half are due to production shift to other countries (mainly China, Malaysia, India, but also Mexico and Italy), and half are due to imports significantly affecting domestic production activity, resulting in layoffs. Firms impacted by production shifts are primarily in the electronics, metals manufacturing, and IT/helpdesk sectors. Sixty-percent of the firms impacted by imports are in the wood products industry.
- Region 10 (Bend/Redmond area) has numerous ARRA-funded home weatherization technician positions listed.

UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- Awaiting response on several grants:
 - Broadband for BES field office upgrade through Dept. of Commerce/NTIA. Awards were initially going to be announced starting November 7, but NTIA announced that this is delayed to December.
 - Green Jobs Labor Market Information through Dept. of Labor – should be awarded prior to December.
