Senate Bill 79 creates the Task Force on Energy Performance Scores ("Task Force"). One of the Task Force's duties is to develop recommendations for a voluntary energy performance scoring system for use in new and existing commercial and residential buildings. Senate Bill 79 directs the Oregon Department of Energy ("Department") to provide staff support to the Task Force and to adopt the Task Force's recommendations for a voluntary energy performance scoring system by July 1, 2010.
