



## **RECOVERY FUNDS TO HELP CLACKAMAS COUNTY**

SALEM - The Oregon Department of Energy awarded \$2,194,221 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to seven energy projects in Clackamas County. These projects vary from energy efficiency projects to the installation of solar arrays and a biomass boiler. The funds are part of the State Energy Program for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects in public buildings.

Altogether the projects are expected to save or produce an estimated 2,425,161 kilowatt hours of electricity per year, enough to heat 202 average Oregon homes per year.

The Estacada School District received \$627,738 to install a \$1.2 million biomass boiler at the Estacada School District office at 255 NE 6<sup>th</sup> Street in Estacada. The new boiler replaces two 20-year-old oil boilers, one of which will be retained to serve as a back-up boiler. The new boiler was manufactured by SolaGen, an Oregon manufacturer, and is expected to save the school district \$83,525 per year in oil costs. Wood chips are expected to cost \$9,280 per year.

Clackamas County received \$400,000 for energy efficiency (lighting, controls, windows, weatherization and boiler) projects at nine different sites: Clackamas County Courthouse, Beaver Creek Clinic, Juvenile Department facility, McCoy building, Emergency Operations Center, Technical Services facility (old Assessor's building), Central Utility plant, OSU Agriculture Extension office, and Corrections Residential facility.

Oregon Parks and Recreation received \$12,000 to install \$30,000 of solar arrays at the sewage pump station at Milo McIver State Park in Estacada.

Canby School District got two lighting awards: one for Eccles Elementary, the other for Knight Elementary.

Lake Oswego School District received \$215,371 for lighting projects at Forest Hills Elementary, Hallinan Elementary, Administration, Facility Operations, Lake Grove Elementary, Lake Oswego Junior High, Oak Creek Elementary, Palisades Elementary, River Grove Elementary, Tech Building, Transportation, Uplands Elementary, Waluga

Junior High, and Westridge Elementary.

North Clackamas School District also received \$794,053 for lighting projects at Alder Creek Middle School, Concord Elementary, Seth Lewelling Elementary, Milwaukie Elementary, Milwaukie High, Mount Scott Elementary, Oregon Trail Elementary, Riverside Elementary, Schellenberg Technology Center School, Clackamas High Annex, View Acres Elementary and Whitcomb Elementary.
