



RECOVERY FUNDS TO HELP CLATSOP COUNTY

SALEM - The Oregon Department of Energy awarded \$357,564 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to six energy projects in Clatsop County. The funds are part of the State Energy Program and Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects.

Altogether the projects are expected to save an estimated 1,345,456 kilowatt hours of electricity per year, enough to heat 112 average Oregon homes per year.

Clatsop County received two awards. One was for \$31,429 to install lighting and controls at the jail, courthouse, and Public Services buildings in Astoria. The other award for \$106,990 was for installation of heating system upgrades, water heater measures and building controls at the county animal shelter in Warrenton, and the jail, courthouse and Public Services buildings in Astoria.

The City of Astoria received two awards. One was for the Astoria Public Safety facility for a \$102,174 heating system upgrade project. The other was for \$79,023 for heating system upgrades at the Astoria Public Library.

Jewell School District received a lighting award of \$5,300. The Clatsop County School District also received a lighting award for \$32,648 for Astoria High School, Astoria Middle School, John Jacob Astor Elementary and Gray School.
