



## RECOVERY FUNDS TO HELP CURRY COUNTY

SALEM - The Oregon Department of Energy awarded \$117,562 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to three energy projects in Curry County. The funds are part of the State Energy Program for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects.

The three projects are expected to save an estimated 66,511 kilowatt hours of electricity per year, enough to heat 5.5 average Oregon homes a year.

Curry County received awards for heating system upgrades and insulation projects at both the North and South Annex facilities.

Port Orford-Langlois School District received \$65,062 for a lighting project at Pacific High School.
