



## RECOVERY FUNDS TO HELP LINCOLN COUNTY

SALEM - The Oregon Department of Energy awarded \$134,472 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (stimulus) funds to energy projects in Lincoln County. The funds are part of the State Energy Program designated for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects.

Altogether the projects are expected to save 99,913 kilowatt hours of electricity per year, enough to heat 8 average Oregon homes per year.

The award is to the Lincoln County School District. Lighting retrofit projects will be implemented at:

- F&M East Shop
- Newport High School East
- Newport High School West
- Sam Case Elementary
- Newport Intermediate School
- Toledo Elementary
