



RECOVERY FUNDS TO HELP LINN COUNTY

SALEM - The Oregon Department of Energy awarded \$296,281 in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to 16 energy projects in Linn County. The funds are part of the State Energy Program and Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects.

Altogether the projects are expected to save an estimated 648,702 kilowatt hours of electricity per year, enough to heat 54 average Oregon homes.

Linn County received multiple awards for heating system upgrades, weatherization projects and lighting retrofits to multiple county facilities.

Central Linn and Scio School District received awards for energy-efficient lighting projects.
