FEES AND EXPENSES

The per diem fee is \$1,200 for each 8-hour day of hearing, study, or writing. The full per diem is charged for all hearing days. Study and writing which do not take a full day are pro-rated accordingly. Travel which occurs outside the actual day of hearing is pro-rated at the per diem rate. All travel expenses are billed from the Seattle, Washington, address, and interim billing is used in cases involving air travel or multiple hearing days. A cancellation fee of \$1,200 is charged for each day of hearing cancelled or postponed within 30 calendar days of hearing.
