FEES:

Per diem fee: My per diem rate is \$1,000 per day for hearing, record study, research, award preparation and travel time. I do not charge for travel time or mileage to or within in Portland, Oregon for hearings held there. For per diem purposes a day is eight hours including lunch.

Cancellation Fee: One day's per diem will be charged for each day reserved for hearing if the cancellation occurs within 15 working days of the scheduled start of the arbitration hearing. For example, if a case is scheduled to be heard beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday the 28th, the cancellation fee will be charged if I am notified of the cancellation anytime after 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday the 8th (15 working days prior to the scheduled hearing date).

Expenses: Transportation:

- (1) Travel in my own car is charged at the current federal rate per mile.
- (2) Other transportation, and parking, is charged at cost.

Meals and Lodging: charged at cost.
