Aneesah I. Furqan, Salem, Oregon, appeared *pro se*.

Sylvia Van Dyke, Assistant Attorney General, Department of Justice, Salem, Oregon, represented Respondent.

Appellant Aneesah I. Furqan, a management service employee with the Department of Human Services (Department), received a written reprimand effective May 29, 2012. On June 29, 2012, Furqan filed an appeal of the reprimand by faxing it to this Board's offices.

An appeal by a management service employee under ORS 240.570(3) must either be received by this board or postmarked not later than 30 days after the effective date of the discipline. ORS 240.560(1), OAR 115-045-0005, and OAR 115-045-0023(4). *Wargnier v. State of Oregon, Department of Consumer and Business Services*, Case No. MA-09-10 (September 2010). Furqan's appeal was filed 31 days after the effective date of the discipline.

By letter dated July 3, 2012, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) asked Furqan to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed as untimely. Furqan did not respond to the ALJ's letter.

Furqan's appeal was not filed within the 30-day limitation period established by ORS 240.560(1). Therefore, the appeal will be dismissed as untimely.


ORDER

The appeal is dismissed.


