On May 2, 2005, Tiffany Land filed this appeal of a reprimand Respondent imposed on her. On September 8, Land left a voice mail message for the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) stating that the matter had been resolved. On September 9, the ALJ wrote Land asking her to confirm that information in writing along with a statement withdrawing her appeal. Land has not withdrawn her appeal or otherwise communicated with the ALJ on the subject

The complaint is dismissed for lack of prosecution.


