DISMISSAL ORDER

Ludibina Abrego, _____, *pro se.*

On October 24, 2007, Appellant Ludibina Abrego filed this appeal under the State Personnel Relations Law (SPRL), ORS chapter 240, alleging that on September 24, 2007, the Department of Human Services (DHS) terminated Appellant's employment in violation of state policy.

BACKGROUND

Appellant was employed in a classified position as a public service representative 3 by DHS. Appellant alleges in her appeal, and we find, that Appellant is represented by SEIU Local 503.

DISCUSSION

ORS 240 086(1) gives this Board jurisdiction to review personnel actions of a state employee "who is *not* in a certified or recognized appropriate collective bargaining unit." (Emphasis added.) Here, Appellant is a member of the SEIU Local 503 bargaining unit; therefore, this Board has no jurisdiction to hear this SPRL appeal. *Teodolina Parra v. State of Oregon, Department of Fish and Wildlife*, Case No. MA-24-03 (November 2003).


ORDER

The appeal is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction


