




representation in regard to his contract rights in appealing that reprimand. The State's April 23, 2010 letter showed that Tucker had been sent a copy.

By letter dated April 26, 2010, the ALJ notified Tucker that she understood the March 24, 2010 reprimand, which was the basis of Tucker's appeal, had been rescinded. The ALJ requested that Tucker withdraw his appeal or show cause by May 7, 2010, why the appeal should not be dismissed. Tucker did not respond. We therefore dismiss this appeal for failure to prosecute.

ORDER

The appeal is dismissed.
