On March 22, 2007, Appellant Fred Monem filed this appeal under the State Personnel Relations Law challenging his removal from state management service. On April 5, 2007, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) granted Monem's request to hold the case in abeyance pending the outcome of a related criminal investigation. On August 8, 2007, the ALJ wrote Monem and asked him to respond as to the status of the investigation and whether he was ready to proceed with his appeal. Monem did not

respond. On October 22, 2007, the ALJ wrote Monem and stated that the ALJ would recommend dismissing Monem's appeal for failure to prosecute unless he responded by November 1, 2007. The ALJ did not receive any response from Monem.

ORDER

The appeal is dismissed.
