
On August 15, 2011, the State of Oregon, Oregon Health Authority (State) notified Michael L. Holcomb that his position was being eliminated and he would be laid off effective September 30, 2011. On September 2, 2011, Holcomb filed this appeal of the layoff. On September 20, 2011, the ALJ ruled that the appeal was premature because the layoff had not yet taken place, but the Board would retain the case file in the event Holcomb wished to renew his appeal once the layoff became effective. On March 20, 2012, the ALJ wrote Holcomb asking the status of the matter. Appellant did not respond to the ALJ's March 20 letter.

ORDER

The appeal is dismissed for failure to prosecute.
