State of Oregon employee giving campaigns are starting to wrap up for 2013, having raised \$730,000 so far. And we're not done yet: the University staff and faculty campaigns continue into 2014. Four agencies earned this year's Awards of Distinction for the highest per-capita giving in different sizes of agencies:

Department of Justice (1000+ employees)

Department of Environmental Quality (500-999 employees)

Department of Housing & Community Services (100-499 employees)

Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (less than 100 employees)
