

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THE EXAM PROCESS

On November 1, 2008 the LCB will no longer be administering the Landscape Construction Professional Exam. The Board has given the administration of this task to PSI, a professional examination administration service who will psychometrically administer the examination in at least 7 locations throughout the state of Oregon.

IMPORTANT DATES during Transition:

- **October 31st** will be the last testing day at our Salem office and **September 30th** will be the last day the LCB will mail tests to any of the DMV's that contract with the LCB.
- **After October 31, 2008**, PSI will offer 7 locations throughout Oregon where you will be able to take the exam:

 - Portland:** 8383 NE Sandy Blvd., Suite 201, Portland, OR

NEW COSTS and TIME LIMITS:

- The cost for the exam will be \$65 for the first section and \$10 for each additional section per sitting. The exam will also have a time limit of 1 hour for each section except the Laws/Rules and Business Practice section and the Irrigation section which will have a two (2) hour time limit for each.

- The Laws and Rules section has changed to include a Business Practice element and is now called: **Laws/Rules and Business Practice** and is the common section for landscape construction professionals and Owner/Managing Employee examinations.
