

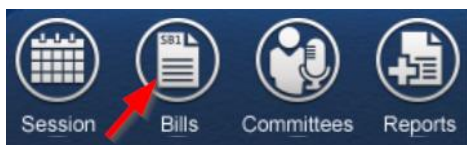
2017 Legislative Bills

There one active bills introduced for the 2017 legislative session that could potentially affect the LCB. Below is brief information about the bill:

House Bill 3337: Creates limited landscape construction professional license. Specifies scope of work that holder of limited license may perform.

- Creates a new limited license (monetary limitation, not scope of work).
- Removes qualifications; experience and education requirements prior to licensing.
- Requires only the backflow exam. While the backflow remains, current exemptions provided to LCB by Electricians Board (low voltage lighting & irrigation control wiring), and CCB (trees) could be jeopardized.
- All Construction Contractors Board licensees would not eligible for this new limited license type.
- The new limited license would be “all phase”, limiting the dollar amount the licensed business can perform to \$8,000 per project in a 12-month period.
- Would become effective 90 days after signed -or- 90 days after Jan 1, 2018; whichever is sooner.
