## **Notice of Federal Concurrence for Routine Program Changes to the Oregon Coastal Management Program (OCMP)**

**(Updates to the Douglas County, City of Nehalem, City of Reedsport, and City of Wheeler  
Comprehensive Plans and Land Use Provisions Incorporated into the OCMP)**

**NOTICE:** Pursuant to 15 CFR Section 923.84 (federal Coastal Zone Management Act regulations), the federal Office for Coastal Management (OCM) has concurred that the incorporation of the following local land use provisions constitute “routine program changes” to the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development’s (DLCD) federally-approved Oregon Coastal Management Program (OCMP).

### **Routine Program Changes:**

- OCM concurred with the incorporation of the Douglas County Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance on December 15, 2015. The initial notice DLCD provided on July 8, 2015 provides details of the routine program change request.
- OCM concurred with the incorporation of the City of Nehalem Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance on December 15, 2015. The initial notice DLCD provided on July 8, 2015 provides details of the routine program change request.
- OCM concurred with the incorporation of the City of Reedsport Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance on December 15, 2015. The initial notice DLCD provided on July 8, 2015 provides details of the routine program change request.
- OCM concurred with the incorporation of the City of Wheeler Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance on December 15, 2015. The initial notice DLCD provided on July 8, 2015 provides details of the routine program change request.

Federal consistency will apply to the changes that OCM approved starting December 16, 2015.
