Notice of Federal Concurrence for a Routine Program Change to the Oregon Coastal Management Program

(Updates to the Clatsop County Comprehensive Plan and Land Use Provisions)

NOTICE: Pursuant to 15 CFR Section 923.84 (federal Coastal Zone Management Act regulations), notice is hereby given that on September 9, 2013, the federal Office of Ocean and Coastal Resources Management (OCRM) informed the Oregon Department of Land Conservation & Development (DLCD) that OCRM has concurred that the following action constitutes a “routine program change” to DLCD’s federally-approved Oregon Coastal Management Program (OCMP).

ROUTINE PROGRAM CHANGE ACTION: Incorporating updates to the Clatsop County Comprehensive Plan, Land and Water Development and Use Ordinance, and Standards Document (Clatsop County land use provisions) into the OCMP. DLCD provided notification on May 7, 2013, regarding this routine program change request; that notice provides details on the action. For reference, the OCRM approval and a list of approved changes is attached to this notice.

Federal consistency will apply to the change that OCRM approved starting September 12, 2013.

Thank you for the Department of Land Conservation's May 3, 2013, request to incorporate the current versions of the Clatsop County Comprehensive Plan (County Plan), the Clatsop County Land and Water Development and Use Ordinance (County Ordinance), and the Clatsop County Development Standards Document (County Standards) (collectively, Clatsop County land use provisions) into the Oregon Coastal Management Program. You requested that the changes described below be incorporated as routine program changes (RPCs), pursuant to Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA) regulations at 15 C.F.R. part 923, subpart H, and Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management (OCRM) Program Change Guidance (July 1996). OCRM received the request on May 13, 2013, and OCRM's decision deadline was extended to September 10, 2013.

Based on our review of your submission, we concur, with the exceptions described below, that the changes are RPCs and we approve the incorporation of the changes as enforceable and non-enforceable policies of the Oregon Coastal Management Program. Federal Consistency will apply to the approved changes to enforceable policies only after you publish notice of this approval pursuant to 15 C.F.R. § 923.84(b)(4), and the new and revised enforceable policies shall only be applied to applications for federal authorizations filed after OCRM's approval. Please include in the public notice the list of changes provided in this letter, and please send a copy of the notice to OCRM.

CHANGES APPROVED

See enclosed list of the changes incorporated into the Oregon Coastal Management Program.

QUALIFICATIONS

States may not incorporate enforceable policies by reference. If an approved enforceable policy refers to another regulation, policy, standard, guidance, or other such requirement or document (hereinafter "referenced policy"), the referenced policy itself must be submitted to and approved by OCRM as an enforceable policy in order to be applied under the federal consistency review provisions of the CZMA. Therefore, no requirement or document referenced in the approved enforceable policies may be applied for federal consistency unless that requirement or document has separately been approved by OCRM.



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CHANGES NOT APPROVED

OCRM has not approved the sections described below because these sections would impose policies on a federal agency. A state policy that purports to regulate or otherwise establish standards for federal agencies or federal lands or waters would not meet the CZMA's definition of "enforceable policy," which requires that state policies be legally binding under state law. *See* 16 U.S.C. § 1453(6a). Since Oregon has no regulatory authority over federal agencies under the CZMA, Policy 7 of Goal P20.12 described below could not be legally binding under state law, as required by CZMA § 304(6a).

Goal P20.12 Mitigation and Restoration, policy 7 of the County Plan, states: "If any of the compensatory mitigation actions are required, the local government shall require that the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service make a Resource Category determination for the site proposed for development." OCRM does not approve this section as an enforceable policy for the reasons stated above.

In addition, OCRM does not approve Goal 7, policies 4 and 8 of the County Plan because they are directives and, therefore, not enforceable policies.

The County Plan also states that the July 2012 Columbia River Estuary Dredged Material Management Plan, in its entirety, is contained in the Goal 16 and 17 element of the County Plan. However, as noted in the "Qualifications" section of this letter, States may not incorporate enforceable policies by reference. Therefore, OCRM does not approve the July 2012 Columbia River Estuary Dredged Material Management Plan, in its entirety, as an enforceable policy. Rather, only the portions of the Management Plan that were submitted for OCRM approval and are included in the enclosed enforceable policies table are approved.

Within the County Ordinance, OCRM does not approve section 5.124 "Consistency Review Procedure for Activities Requiring State or Federal Permits or Licenses." This section purports to place in the County the responsibility for issuing CZMA federal consistency, and as such, directly contravenes the CZMA Federal Consistency regulations at 15 C.F.R. 930.6 which provides that only the State may issue CZMA federal consistency decisions. While this was not proposed as an enforceable policy, OCRM wants to be clear that Section 5.124 is inoperable.

Finally, OCRM is clarifying that OCRM is not approving any "necessary data and information" for purposes of starting the CZMA six-month federal consistency review period under 15 C.F.R. § 930.58(a)(2) as part of the Clatsop County land use provisions RPC.

PUBLIC AND FEDERAL AGENCY COMMENTS

Fulbright and Jaworski, LLC, submitted extensive comments to OCRM on behalf of LNG Development Company, LLC and Oregon Pipeline Company, LLC (collectively, Oregon LNG) ("LNG" refers to Liquefied Natural Gas). Fulbright and Jaworski submitted comments to OCRM, dated May 23, 2013, and Oregon followed up with comments to OCRM dated July 15,

2013. Subsequently, Fulbright and Jaworski submitted additional comments to OCRM dated August 9, 2013. In addition, OCRM prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) under the National Environmental Policy Act for the RPC and OCRM received comments on the draft EA from both the State of Oregon and Fulbright and Jaworski.

OCRM's response to the RPC comments is enclosed in the "OCRM Summary Response to Comments," which also summarizes the comments. OCRM also considered the comments received regarding the draft EA, which were taken into consideration when OCRM drafted the final EA.
