## Public Notice

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Department of Land Conservation & Development (DLCD) is accepting comments on the draft *Coastal Zone Management Act §309 Assessment and Strategy 2016–2020*. This document represents the Oregon Coastal Management Program's (OCMP) proposal for funds available under Section 309 of the federal Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA).

Section 309 of the CZMA, as amended in 1990 and 1996, establishes a voluntary coastal zone enhancement program to encourage states and territories to develop program changes in one or more of the following nine coastal enhancement areas: wetlands, coastal hazards, public access, marine debris, cumulative and secondary impacts, special area management plans, ocean resources, energy and government, facility siting, and aquaculture. Under this program, the Secretary of Commerce is authorized to make awards to states and territories to develop and submit for federal approval program changes that support attainment of the objectives of one or more of the enhancement areas.
