NOTICE: Pursuant to 15 CFR Section 923.84 (federal Coastal Zone Management Act regulations), the federal Office of Ocean and Coastal Resources Management (OCRM) has concurred that the incorporation of changes to the listed statutes, except where not conferred by OCRM, are “routine program changes” to the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development’s (DLCD) federally-approved Oregon Coastal Management Program (OCMP).
