**Proposed Federal Action:** U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Reissuance of Nationwide Permits

**Project Location:** Nationwide, including Oregon's coastal zone

**Comments Due to DLCD:** April 8, 2011

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Land Conservation & Development, as provided in Section 307(c) of the Coastal Zone Management Act, is reviewing the following federal action for consistency with the Oregon Coastal Management Program. **PROPOSED FEDERAL ACTION:** The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is proposing to reissue 48 of its existing Nationwide Permits (NWP) and issue two (2) new NWP. NWP are general permits issued on a nationwide basis to streamline the authorization of activities that result in minimal individual and cumulative adverse effects on the aquatic environment.

The proposed NWP, general conditions, and definitions were published in the Federal Register on February 16, 2011. The Federal Register notice is available at: [www.gpoaccess.gov/fr/](http://www.gpoaccess.gov/fr/) and on the DLCD/OCMP public notice page (address above).

In addition to the nationwide general conditions, the Corps of Engineers Portland District has proposed regional conditions that are specific to the needs and requirements of Oregon. The District's public notice and the proposed regional conditions are available on the DLCD/OCMP public notice page (address above).

**COASTAL ZONE REVIEW CRITERIA:** DLCD is soliciting comments on the proposed action's consistency with the Oregon Coastal Management Program. Comments should address whether the proposed NWP, general conditions, and regional conditions are consistent with the applicable elements of the Oregon Coastal Management Program, including:

- Statewide Planning Goals
- Acknowledged Local Comprehensive Plans & Implementing Ordinances
- State Authorities incorporated into the Oregon Coastal Management Program (e.g., Removal-Fill Law, Water Quality Standards, Fish and Wildlife Regulations), as applicable.

**INCONSISTENT?** If you believe this project is inconsistent with the Oregon Coastal Management Program, your comments to DLCD should explain why you believe the project is inconsistent and should identify the Oregon Coastal Management Program element(s) in question. You should also describe how the project could be modified, if possible, to make it consistent.
