RE: TSPAC Subcommittees

The Territorial Sea Plan Advisory Committee has created subcommittees to address certain topical issues that need to be resolved as part of the draft TSP amendment. The subcommittees will operate with DLCD staff as coordinators, and will function under the LCDC guidelines for advisory committees and the protocols established for conducting rule making advisory committee activities. Below is a list of the subcommittees, staff, basic tasks, and members. TSPAC members who were not present when the subcommittees were created may already be listed as subcommittee members based on their established interest in the topic, or they may wish to be added.

1. Fisheries Resources:

Task

- Develop a solution for how to incorporate the fishing maps into the zones, including the new crab maps and those OPAC received from the PC Doreyman.
- Develop specific screening criteria that would be used to assess the adverse impact within each zone, both for each fishing sector and the individual ports.
