SUBJECT: 2007-2009 Technical Assistance and Periodic Review Grants

The Department of Land Conservation and Development is pleased to again offer grant awards for land use planning projects in the State of Oregon. The application form and instructions for Technical Assistance and Periodic Review grants for the 2007-09 biennium are enclosed.

DLCD has received a final budget for the 2007-2009 biennium of approximately \$2.5 million, and grant funds will be awarded on a first come, first served bases. The intent for distributing applications now is to encourage potential grantees to begin formulating project descriptions and budgets so that applications may be submitted and acted upon as quickly as possible.

The enclosed materials address **only** Technical Assistance and Periodic Review grants. Other grants from the department's general fund (e.g., Planning Assistance and Columbia River Gorge grants) will be available through separate processes. The department will contact jurisdictions eligible for these other grants directly.

Please be sure to carefully complete the grant application, as well-constructed proposals will have a better chance of success and complete information will speed an award. If you have any questions, be sure to contact the appropriate individual as explained in the application materials.
