1. **Review of March 3, 2006 Task Force Minutes.** The task force will review the minutes of the March 3, 2006 meeting.
2. **Old Business.** Staff will present brief reports with additional information on issues of interest to the task force that were raised at the March 3 task force meeting.
3. **Task Force Discussion.** This time is reserved for a discussion among members of the task force regarding their interest in serving on the task force, their perceptions of the strengths and weaknesses of the land use planning program, and their objectives and hoped-for outcomes for the task force.
4. **Informational Presentation by the Oregon University Consortium on Land Use Planning.** The Oregon University Consortium on Land Use Planning will present an informational overview of how the task force may address and implement a work plan. This presentation will focus on a process by which the task force may wish to carry out its work; it will not propose substantive outcomes or objectives.
5. **Task Force Business.** Senate Bill 82 requires the task force to report to the Governor and legislative leadership with a preliminary work plan by June 3, 2006. Discussion will address strategies and timelines for meeting this requirement. The task force reserves this time to discuss other items of business relating to the organization and operation of the task force. Such items may include, but are not limited to, future meetings, appointment of subcommittees and related workgroups, appointment of consultants to serve the task force, strategies for public outreach and participation, and solicitation of additional resources to support the work of the task force.

The Oregon Task Force on Land Use Planning was established under Senate Bill 82 (2005). The purpose of the task force is to study and make recommendations on: (a) The effectiveness of Oregon's land use planning program in meeting current and future needs of Oregonians in all parts of the state; (b) The respective roles and responsibilities of state and local governments in land use planning; and (c) Land use issues specific to areas inside and outside urban growth boundaries and the interface between areas inside and outside urban growth boundaries. The task force receives staff support from the Department of Land Conservation and Development.
