### **CITIZEN INVOLVEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE (CIAC) UPDATE & RECOMMENDATION TO FILL VACANCY**

#### **I. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY**

This agenda item has two parts:

1. A CIAC oral report to LCDC on its recent work, including education and outreach events in Prineville and Tillamook; and
2. CIAC is asking LCDC to fill its vacancy in Congressional District 2.

#### **A. Type of Action and Commission Role**

1. No action needed. CIAC will give an oral overview of its two written reports on education and outreach events in Prineville (October 16, 2008) and Tillamook (December 4, 2008). The written reports are *Attachment A*.
2. LCDC will select between two finalists to fill the CIAC's District 2 vacancy. The position was held by Jack Johnson (Cove) since 2000. The two applications are *Attachment B*.

#### **II. BACKGROUND**

Johnson's term ended on December 31, 2008.

On September 17, 2008, DLCD broadly advertised the CIAC vacancy. The due date for

applications was October 31, 2008.

DLCD received applications from six people:

1. Mollie Eder of Powell Butte;
2. Roberta Donovan of Nyssa;
3. Kathie Stoddard of John Day;
4. Robert Moore of Klamath Falls;
5. Karen Swirsky of Bend; and
6. Ken Wick of Joseph.

CIAC members were e-mailed all six applications in early November. Each CIAC member was asked to rank the applicants and e-mail those rankings to DLCD's Communications Officer (Cliff Voliva).

Voliva and Chair Ann Glaze determined that Eder and Donovan tied for first in the compiled ranking and would be the finalists to be interviewed.

Voliva set up two December 15 conference calls between the candidates and a CIAC subcommittee consisting of Chris White, Ian Maitland and Don Greene, and DLCD Director Richard Whitman.

At the CIAC meeting on Friday, February 20, 2009, the committee discussed the two applicants.

### **III. RECOMMENDATION**

CIAC will offer its recommendation orally to the Commission.
