



Opinion by Ryan.

On October 24, 2012, the Board received petitioner's notice of intent to appeal. The notice was not accompanied by a check for the filing fee and deposit for costs required by OAR 661-010-0015(4). On October 25, 2012, the Board requested by letter that petitioner remit payment of the filing fee and deposit for costs within seven calendar days from the date of the letter, and in the letter notified petitioner that if the filing fee and deposit for costs were not received within the prescribed period, the Board would dismiss the appeal.

The Board did not receive the required filing fee and deposit for costs within the prescribed period. Accordingly, pursuant to OAR 661-010-0015(1)(c), this appeal is dismissed.
