1 **NATURE OF THE DECISION**

2 Petitioner appeals a city ordinance that amends the Portland City Code's sign
3 regulations.

4 **DISMISSAL**

5 This appeal was suspended on February 4, 2000 at the request of the parties. On July
6 13, 2013, the Board requested by letter that the parties advise it of the current status of the
7 appeal within 14 days, and notified the parties that if the Board did not receive a response
8 from the parties within 14 days of the date of the letter, the Board would dismiss the appeal.
9 No party responded to our letter.

10 On September 27, 2013 the Board issued an order advising the parties that it would
11 issue a final opinion and order dismissing the appeal unless one of the parties objected within
12 14 days of the date of the order. No party objected.

13 The appeal is dismissed.
