


1 Intervenor's objection is not to supplementing the record
2 but to enlarging the time within which petitioner may file his
3 petition for review. However, the time to file the petition
4 for review does not begin to run until the record is complete.
5 Oregon Laws 1979, Ch 772, §4(6). It is "the entire record
6 of the proceeding" that must be submitted to the Board, and
7 the Board has the power to "require or permit" corrections to
8 that record. Oregon Laws 1979, Ch 772, §4(5). Again, as the
9 omission in the record in this case is of the greatest import-
10 ance, the Board finds that the record is not complete, and the
11 time to file a petition for review does not begin to run until
12 the land use decision and any accompanying findings are trans-
13 mitted to the Board.

14 Jefferson County shall have until February 15, 1980 to
15 file the omitted portions of the record with this Board.
16 Petitioner may then have 20 days after the transmittal of that
17 record to file his petition for review.
