HB2058	Standardizes health related licensing boards; removed reference to DHS in 692.300	On passage	
HB2059	Adds standardized mandatory reporting requirements for the licensees of all health related licensing boards; adds standard definitions for prohibited and unprofessional conduct	On passage	Applies to all forms of license, certification and registration. Requires reporting to all boards.
HB2118	Standardizes health related licensing boards; for board membership requirements, executive director reporting; peer review audits, public member participations; standardizes language around impairment.	On passage	
HB2345	Requires all health related licensing boards to use a standard process for the creation and management of impaired practitioner programs.	On passage	The Board does not currently have a program, but this bill allows but does not require a program for OMCB.
SB274	Relates to the administrative law process, appointment of judges and evidentiary requirements	On passage	
SB796	Addresses many aspects of death care. Sections relating to the laying out of cemeteries, definitions, indigent burial, and addressing environmental standards were effective on passage. Other provisions relating to the formation of new license requirements for death care consultants, final disposition companies and all other sections are effective in March 2010.	Varies
