

Preparing for the National Licensure Examination

The National Association of Boards of Examiners of Long Term Care Administrators (NAB) offers candidates for licensure many resources to assist in preparing for the national licensure examination: *Information for Candidates Handbooks, Study Guides, Practice Exams, a List of Recommended References* and the ability to purchase these reference materials from the NAB website. About the Practice Examinations

NAB has made available practice exams to assist Nursing Home Administrator (NHA) and Residential Care/Assisted Living Administrator (RCAL) exam candidates in preparing for the national licensure examination. The practice exam simulates the actual exam experience and will assist in identifying how well a candidate is prepared as well as areas of weakness. The performance results of a completed exam will identify the overall scaled score and percentage scores for each of the content domains. Exam candidates may utilize the performance feedback in their preparation and development of an individualized study plan.

The cost for either practice examination is \$75 or \$125 for both the NHA and RCAL examinations (when registering for both exams at the same time). Interested persons may register or view more information on the practice examinations at www.nabweb.org.
