Revised OAR 436-015, "Managed Care Organization (MCO) Rules"

- Similar to primary care physicians and authorized nurse practitioners, starting Jan.1, 2014, a chiropractic physician may continue to treat an MCO enrolled patient if the chiropractic physician has established a documented history of treatment with the patient prior to the date of injury, has maintained the patient's medical records, and agrees to comply with the MCO's terms and conditions (such as refer the patient to MCO panel providers).
