## Current Openings on the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners

Public Notice                      March 24, 2014

One professional member and one public member position are currently under consideration by the Governor for appointment. Christine Robinson DC, Medford, is not applying for a second term. Public member Douglas Dick, Manzanita, has served the allowed two terms.

Board terms are for three years. The appointment is subject to confirmation by the State Senate.

Both incumbents reside outside the Willamette Valley corridor, so applications from Southern, Eastern or Coastal Oregon may be given additional consideration so as to ensure geographical diversity on this board. See Oregon 684.130 below.

Women, people of color, and bilingual persons are encouraged to apply. (ORS 676.400)

The OBCE encourages interested persons to have previous experience on one of our standing committees, such as Peer Review, Administrative Rules Advisory or ETSDP (devices & procedures)

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners consists of five chiropractic physicians and two public members. The Board meets bimonthly to consider licensing, examination, discipline and practice issues affecting chiropractic health care in Oregon. Board members are expected to review executive session issues and complaints at every meeting, and address numerous policy and practice issues. They receive \$155 a day per diem and travel mileage.

**684.130 State Board of Chiropractic Examiners.** (1) There is established the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners. The board consists of seven members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate in the manner provided in ORS 171.562 and 171.565. All members of the board must be residents of this state. Of the members of the board:

(a) Five must be chiropractors; and

(b) Two must be members of the public who are not chiropractors or a spouse, domestic partner, child, parent or sibling of a chiropractor.

(2)(a) Board members required to be chiropractors may be selected by the Governor from a list of three to five nominees for each vacancy, submitted by any professional organization representing chiropractors.

(b) The chiropractor members must have practiced chiropractic in this state for five years prior to appointment.

(c) In selecting the members of the board, the Governor shall strive to balance the representation on the board according to:

(A) Geographic areas of this state; and

(B) Ethnic group.

(3)(a) Annually, upon the expiration of the term of any member of the board, the Governor shall appoint one or more qualified persons to the board to serve for a period of three years. A member serves at the pleasure of the Governor. The terms must be staggered so that no more than three terms end each year. If a vacancy occurs in the membership of the board for any reason, the Governor shall make an appointment to become immediately effective for the unexpired term.

(b) A board member shall be removed immediately from the board if, during the member's term, the member:

(A) Is not a resident of this state;

(B) Has been absent from three consecutive board meetings, unless at least one absence is excused; or

(C) Is not a licensed chiropractor or a retired chiropractor who was a licensed chiropractor in good standing at the time of retirement, if the board member was appointed to serve on the board as a chiropractor.
