Public Board Member Opening

There is one public member position on the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners are now under consideration by the Governor for appointment.

Women, people of color, and bilingual persons are encouraged to apply. Applicants from the East side of the Cascades are encouraged to apply to improve the geographic representation on the Board.

All appointments are subject to confirmation by the State Senate. Terms are for three years.

A chiropractic physician or public person wishing to be considered should submit the Interest Form directly to the Governor's Executive Appointments office. The Board of Chiropractic Examiners consists of five chiropractic physicians and two public members. The Board meets bimonthly to consider licensing, examination, discipline and practice issues affecting chiropractic health care in Oregon. Board members are expected to review executive session issues and complaints at every meeting, and address numerous policy and practice issues. Board members also participate in outreach to chiropractors and other stakeholders at forums and meetings around the state.

The Board meets on third Thursdays in January, March, May, July, September and November. Board members receive \$155 per diem a day and mileage for travel to and from meetings.
