Background

The 2007 Legislature included Budget Notes in the Oregon Economic and Community Development Department's 2007-09 Budget which ask the 13 Regional Investment Boards to develop an inventory of the priority infrastructure (and other capital improvement) needs for their respective regions, in accordance with priority criteria established by the Oregon Economic and Community Development Commission ("Commission").

The Budget Notes then direct the Commission to consolidate the regional inventories into a statewide inventory, which will be used to prepare a funding request for the Legislature to consider during the February 2008 Legislative Session.

In addition to the Legislature's use of the inventory, the Oregon Economic and Community Development Department will, along with other funding criteria, use the inventory as a guide for funding projects from its Infrastructure Programs.

General Instructions

1. Browser Requirements

The Infrastructure Inventory System requires Internet Explorer version 6.x or 7.x. To determine your version: in Internet Explorer, click "Help"; then "About Internet Explorer".

2. Settings in Internet Explorer

For version 6:

- a. In Internet Explorer, click "Tools"; "Internet Options"; "Temporary Internet Files - Settings". Change "Check for newer versions of stored pages" to "Every visit to the page". Click "OK", then "OK" again.
- b. In Internet Explorer, click "Tools"; "Internet Options"; "Advanced" tab. In the "Settings" list, under "Browsing Options", locate the line "Show friendly HTTP error messages" and uncheck the box next to that line. Click "Apply", then "OK".

For version 7:

- a. In Internet Explorer, click "Tools"; "Internet Options"; "General" tab; "Browsing History - Settings". In the "Temporary Internet Files" section, change "Check for newer versions of stored pages" to "Every time I visit the web page". Click "OK", then "OK" again.
- b. In Internet Explorer, click "Tools"; "Internet Options"; "Advanced" tab. In the "Settings" list, under "Browsing Options", locate the line "Show friendly HTTP error messages" and uncheck the box next to that line. Click "Apply", then "OK".

2. User Name and Password

Each region has been assigned a unique User Name and Password. Please contact the Regional Investment Board Staff for your region's User Name and Password (see next page).

The User Name and Password will allow you to enter projects which are located in that region's counties. If you have a project located in another region, you will need to obtain that region's User Name and Password.

3. Types of Projects to be included in the Inventory

The Inventory contains more than just water and sewer projects; however, not all types of projects are included in this Inventory. Please see page 6 for the types of projects that are to be included.

4. Timing and Phasing of Projects

For the Inventory, a "project" will consist of both the planning work and the construction work. For each project, you will need to enter the date the project is needed by (i.e., when does it need to be completed). This will allow us to prepare a biennial funding request for the Legislature.

5. First Screen: Adding/Editing a Project

After entering the User Name and Password, a list of the projects in the region will be shown. The list can be sorted by any of the columns (click on the column heading). The status of the project can be changed in this screen. "Active" means the project will be pursued. "Inactive" means the project will no longer be pursued or has been completed.

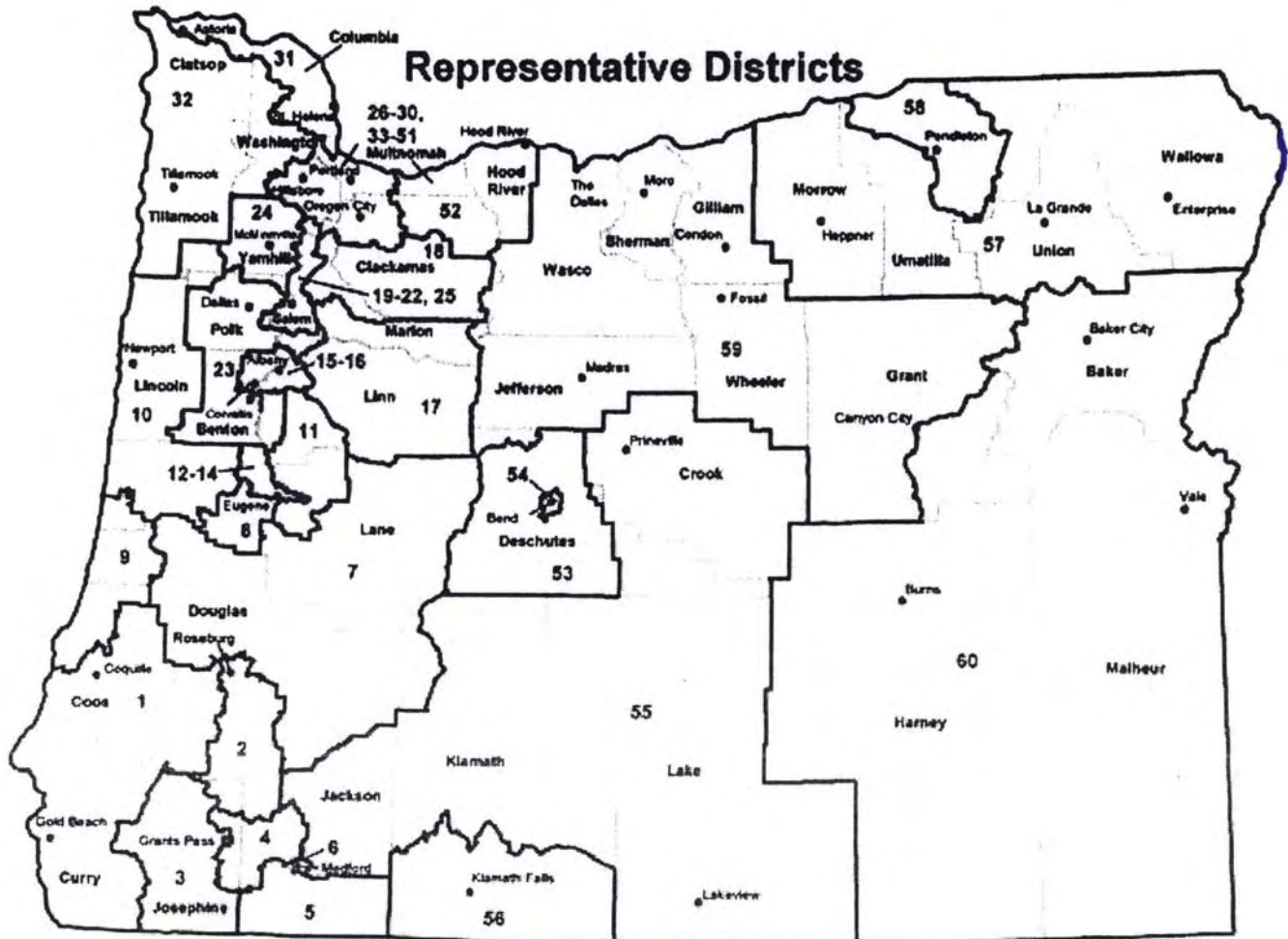

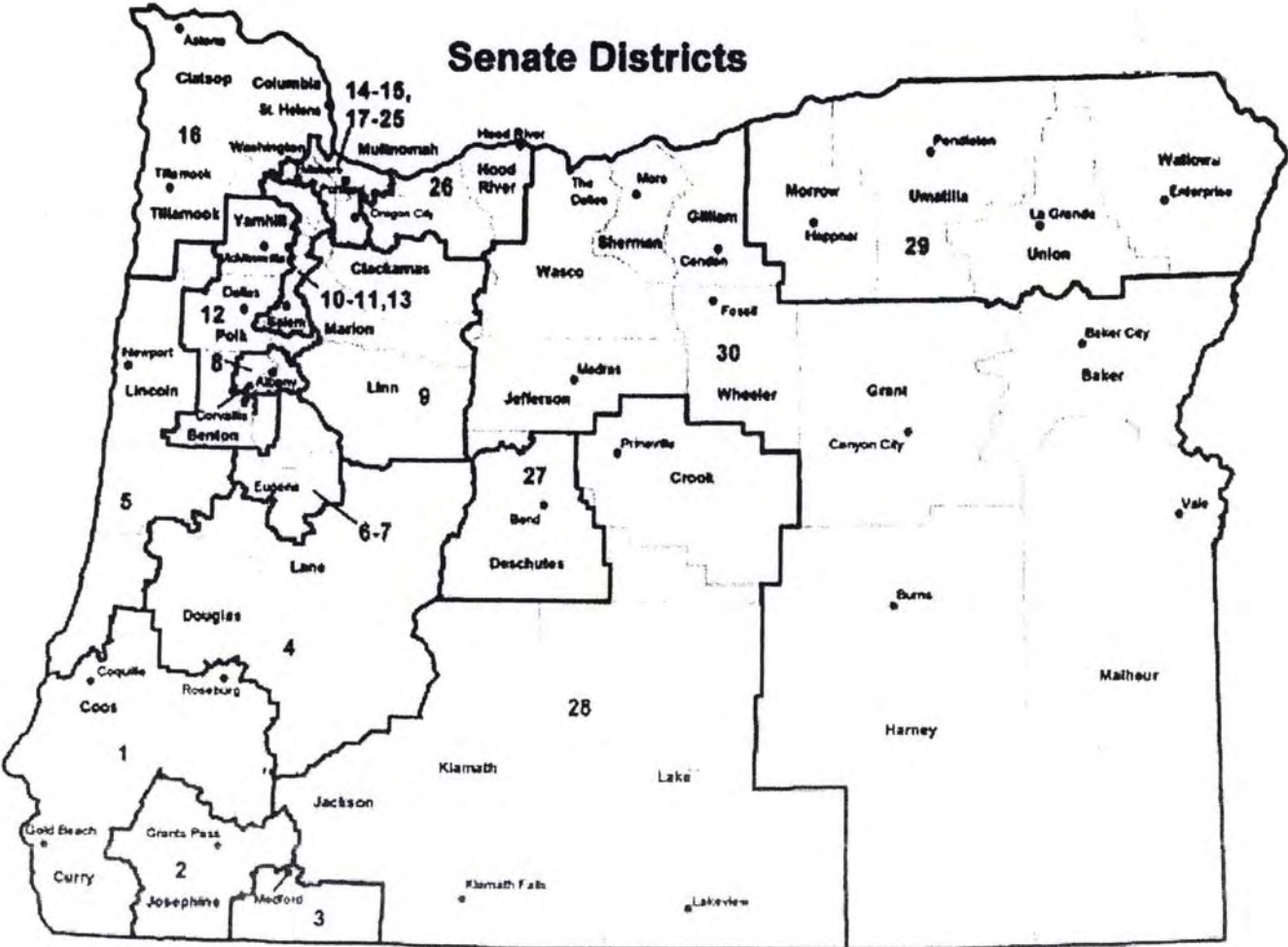
