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READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY!

Students Must Attain a Minimum Score of "70 Points" on Each Exam in order to pass. After you complete your Exam and have passed "Core" and at least one (1) other atomic area you may then apply for a "TEMPORARY PERMIT" which is necessary to complete your PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE.

Upon completion of the required Board Approved School Class Courses, Students are allowed ONE-YEAR (1) to satisfy all the Board Licensure Requirements which include submitting an application for a "Permanent Limited Permit" or to add atomic areas to an existing permit.

ABOUT PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE EVALUATIONS

Practical experience evaluations may be completed in one of the following ways:

- 1.) **ON-SITE:** The evaluator observes the student doing the actual radiographic exams and completes an evaluation form for each procedure that is observed.
- 2.) **OFF-SITE (or) PEER POSITIONING:** The student brings the radiographic exams to the evaluator to be critiqued. A peer is brought to the evaluation session to be used to demonstrate how the patient was positioned in order to achieve the radiographs being critiqued. The evaluator completes an evaluation form for each exam that is critiqued.
- 3.) **THE LIMITED PERMIT STUDENT** shall provide a copy of the signed certificate or the evaluation form(s) to the Board at the address listed above on this form.

QUALIFIED PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE EVALUATORS

The practical experience evaluation must be performed by a license radiologic technologist registered with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologist (ARRT).

The practical experience evaluator is responsible for completing one evaluation form for "each" of the exams evaluated. Upon completing the practical experience evaluation, the evaluator will provide the student with copies of the evaluation forms. When the student has successfully passed the evaluation the evaluator may provide a signed certificate of completion. The practical experience evaluator must retain the evaluation form(s) for a period of two (2) years.
