

## ARRT Limited Scope Examinations

To meet the **eligibility requirements** for each **weekly exam sign-up deadline** a candidate will need to submit:

- A **completed** Limited Scope of Practice in Radiography or Limited Scope Bone Densitometry Equipment Operator exam application.  
The applications are available online [www.oregon.gov/RadTech](http://www.oregon.gov/RadTech).
- A copy of their "Course Completion Certificate"  
The Core Module and all extremities or the Bone Densitometry course must be **completed in its entirety**.  
\*OBRT does not require a Permanent Limited Permit Holder to complete the "Core Module" course only the specific category/extremity they wish to add to their licensure. The Board recommends this course as **ARRT requires all candidates to take and pass the "Core Module" section** of the examination along with any "Specific Radiographic Procedure" (Category).
- Appropriate fee Money order or cashiers check only.  
ARRT Administrative fee \$75.00 each examination  
OBRT Administrative fee \$20.00 each specific category/extremity taken (including "Core module")

**As of January 1st, 2008 the ARRT administrative fee will be \$100.00**

**Examination fees are not refundable or transferable.**

After the candidate's eligibility is confirmed; Board staff will submit their name to ARRT. **ARRT will assign a 90-day examination window**. The candidate may schedule their exam appointment for any time during they set examination window. ARRT will send to each candidate an *Examination Handbook for the Limited Scope of Practice in Radiography or Bone Densitometry Equipment Operator* outlining examination procedures and content specifications.

The handbook also includes a sample Limited Scope Candidate Status Report. The status report indicates which modules of the exam have been assigned. This is the ARRT's only direct contact with limited scope candidates. All candidate information (name or address changes) must be updated through OBRT. **Candidate examination fees are not refundable or transferable.**

All candidates taking the *Limited Scope of Practice in Radiography* **must take and pass** with a score of 70, the "**Core Module**" and any other extremities in which they are eligible.

The candidate is responsible to schedule their examination appointment with Pearson VUE directly. **It must be within the 90 day examination window assigned by ARRT**; clear instructions are outlined in the examination handbook.

**ARRT will score examinations and provide the results directly to OBRT**, reported as number-right scores, on each examination section for all limited scope candidates (as identified on the state-submitted list). Upon notification from ARRT, OBRT will distribute score reports to limited scope candidates.
