1.

Pursuant to ORS chapter 687, the Oregon Board of Massage Therapists (Board) is the agency responsible for licensing, disciplining and regulating massage therapists in the State of Oregon.

2.

Sandra K. Fox (Respondent) is not licensed to practice as a massage therapist in the State of Oregon. Respondent's last known address is 16840 SW LYNX CT, CROOKED RIVER RANCH, OR 97760.

FINDINGS OF FACTS

3.

Licensee failed to cooperate in the Board's continuing education audit process. As such, the Board is prepared to issue a Notice of Suspension until such time as compliance is met.

4.

4.1 On 02/25/2013, the Board received Licensee's application for massage license renewal. A license was issued on 03/05/2013, which is valid through 04/30/2015.

4.2 Licensee was randomly selected for a continuing education audit and a letter was issued on 03/06/2013 indicating that she had 30 days to furnish documentation to verify her 25 hours of continuing education as well as proof of current CPR certification. A continuing education audit summary form was included with the letter. The letter further indicated that failure to comply within the time period could result in disciplinary action from the Board. Licensee failed to deliver the requested documents within the 30 day time period nor did she contact the Board office; her file was forwarded to the Board compliance department.

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ORDER

7.

Based on the foregoing, the Board ORDERS:

7.1 Pursuant to ORS 687.250(2), issue a civil penalty for One violation of OAR 334-040-0010(19)(a), failure to cooperate with the Board in any licensing action or disciplinary proceeding, including but not limited to failure to furnish any requested papers or documents, for a total civil penalty of \$500.

7.2 Suspend Licensee's massage license until she has complied with all continuing education requirements; and

7.3 Licensee is assessed costs of this disciplinary proceeding, including attorney fees.
