FINAL DEFAULT ORDER ON EMERGENCY  
SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION

The Oregon Board of Massage Therapists (Board) is the agency responsible for licensing regulating and disciplining massage therapists in the State of Oregon. See ORS Chapter 678. On September 23, 2013 and pursuant to ORS 678.081(3), the Board determined that the continued practice of massage therapy by Andreas M. Correa (Licensee) constitutes a serious danger to the public. The Board issued an emergency suspension order at that time. The Board also issued a Notice of Proposed Discipline for Revocation of the license as well. The Suspension order and Revocation notice were based on the following findings of facts:

**FINDINGS OF FACTS**

1.

Andreas M. Correa (Licensee) is currently licensed to practice as a massage therapist in the State of Oregon and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board. Licensee holds LMT 16017. Licensee's last known address is 4745 SW Maplewood Rd., Portland, OR 97219.

2.

A complaint was received on June 28, 2013 indicating the licensee was having a sexual relationship with his clients.

3.

3.1 Victim A stated she had purchased a Groupon for \$35 in March 2013, for a massage from the licensee. She also paid for an additional massage at full price. During the first massage session A stated she was lying on her back while licensee was massaging her right shoulder. A stated she was holding her breast away from the shoulder to allow access. Licensee told her that looked uncomfortable and to let it go and continued to massage the shoulder and then started massaging her breast without permission.

1 Client A said she was surprised at first, but it felt good so she didn't stop him. Licensee then performed  
2 oral sex on her and then intercourse on the massage table. A stated they then had intercourse on the  
3 floor next to the massage table. Andreas had another client scheduled after her so they agreed she would  
4 come back later in the afternoon to finish the massage. A returned in the afternoon and they had sexual  
5 intercourse on the massage table during that session.

6 3.2 Client B stated that she met the licensee at the Oregon Athletic Club in August 2012. During  
7 this time B would receive massage and exercise training from the licensee. Client B also stated that during  
8 this time while she was the licensee's client she also had a sexual affair with the license.

9 3.3 During the investigation, Licensee admitted to having a sexual relationship with both client  
10 both client A and B victims while they were his clients. Licensee also admitted to a sexual relationship and  
11 cohabitating with another client, client C, a sexual relationship with Client D and Client E, who both started  
12 out as clients and then became sexual partners.

13 3.4 On September 24, 2013 the Board filed an Emergency Order for Suspension against Licensee  
14 based on the above.

15 3.5 On that same date the Board filed a Proposed Notice for Revocation of Licensee's massage  
16 license.

17 3.6 On September 30, 2013 Licensee requested a hearing on both the Emergency Suspension  
18 order and Proposed Notice of Revocation. Licensee was emergency suspended from September 24, 2013  
19 through November 4, 2013.

20 3.7 A hearing was set for November 4, 2013 on both matters.

21 3.8 On October 31, 2013, Licensee withdrew his request for hearing on both matters.

22 3.9 In the Notices that Licensee received, Licensee was notified that the Board would make a  
23 default record on the record herein if the Licensee were to fail to request a hearing or withdraw it.

24 Licensee is now in default.

25 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

26 4.

Based on the acts and conduct described above, the Board finds by way of default, that the

1 Licensee committed:

2 4.1 Five violations of OAR 334-040-0010 (21)(B)(i) – Sexual violation which is sex between  
3 the LMT and the Client.

4 **ORDER**

5 5.

6 Based on the foregoing, the Board ORDERS:

7 Licensee has committed five violations of OAR 334-040-0010(21)(B)(i) and his massage license in  
8 the State of Oregon is hereby revoked.
