Education committee is communicating directly with the schools to what they should teach in Oregon. Not all the Pathologies or Muscles need to be taught. We should know all of these for our own muscle list, as we need to identify them for our charting. The committee/board should consider what various trade organizations what they would like to see in an LMT. Such as what skills would Physical Therapists or Chiropractors like to see in an LMT to hire them rather than others performing massage. Is our muscle list in sync with what PT assistants learn.
