







1           2) He did not attend an approved undergraduate program,  
2 pursuant to ORS 685.060 and OAR 850-10-010, of at least two years  
3 of liberal arts and sciences in a college or university, in  
4 violation of ORS 685.020.

5           3) He is not qualified to practice naturopathy in the State  
6 of Oregon because he does not have sufficient educational qualifi-  
7 cations pursuant to ORS 685.060 and 685.010 and OAR 850-10-010, in  
8 violation of ORS 685.020.

9           4) He misrepresented his qualifications when he initially  
10 applied for licensure in Oregon by leading the Board to believe  
11 that he possessed satisfactory educational qualifications under ORS  
12 chapter 685 when he did not, in violation of ORS 685.110(1), (6),  
13 and OAR 850-10-010 and OAR 850-10-190(3).

14           You have the right to a hearing to contest these charges if  
15 you desire one by requesting a hearing before the Board within 21  
16 days of receipt of this Notice. If you do not request a hearing,  
17 or fail to appear at any hearing scheduled for your benefit, the  
18 Board may issue an Order by default upholding the penalty. The  
19 record at a default hearing will consist of the Board's licensing  
20 and complaint files concerning these charges. If you request a  
21 hearing, an additional Notice of Contested Case Rights and  
22 Procedures will be provided to you, or you may request it from the  
23 Board's office at any time. An answer to this Notice must be  
24 filed with a request for a hearing, pursuant to OAR 850-01-010  
25 (attached with OAR 850-01-015). Any hearing conducted will follow  
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1 ORS Chapter 183, the APA, and you will have the right to judicial  
2 review.
