CONSENT ORDER

1.

The Board of Naturopathic Examiners (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining naturopathic physicians in the State of Oregon.

Julie K. Parke, N.D., (Licensee) is a licensed naturopathic physician currently practicing in Cottage Grove, Oregon, and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board. Licensee also holds a certificate of special competency in natural childbirth issued by the Board and subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.

2.

Licensee agrees that for the next 12 childbirths for which she is the attending physician she will:

(a) beginning at 24 weeks of gestation, provide by facsimile, e-mail or personal delivery within 48 hours after the visit, chart notes of all prenatal visits to a Board-approved natural childbirth provider (Natural childbirth certified Naturopathic physician or licensed midwife), who has agreed to supervise and be present at the childbirth, and,

(b) notify the supervisor by telephone at the initial signs of the onset of labor and consult with the supervisor thereafter, as determined by the supervisor. The supervisor must be present at the childbirth.

The supervisor must send a written report to the Board at the end of the supervisory relationship.

3.

Licensee must obtain a minimum of six (6) hours of Board approved continuing education in medical ethics. These hours must be completed by September 30, 2004.

4.

Licensee must obtain fifteen (15) hours of Board approved continuing education in obstetrics during each of the next two years, in addition to the 15 hours of OB continuing education required for natural childbirth certification. These hours must be obtained in programs that contain current and review information that is less than five (5) years old.

5.

Licensee must pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$500 for the willful violation of the standard of practice in natural childbirth, and a civil penalty in the amount of \$500, for deliberate misrepresentation in patient health care.

6.

Licensee understands that failure to comply with any condition of this consent order or statute, rule or order of the Board, will be a violation of this agreement and the Board could take further disciplinary action including, but not limited to suspension or revocation of her license.

7.

This Consent Order will go into effect on the date that the Board signs the Order. This order will remain in effect until all conditions of this order are satisfied and Licensee has interviewed with the Board on or near the completion of the requirements set forth in this order.
