

Oregon Board of Psychologist Examiners
CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS
Brief Overview

Basic Requirements (858-040-0015)

New licensees (licensed less than one year) are not required to acquire or report CE. You must acquire at least 50 CE credits during the 24 months immediately preceding your renewal date. Special requirements apply if you are going from inactive to active status. Please call Kelli Kelly at 503-373-1146 for more information.

- Odd-numbered licensees will renew their license and attest to completing fifty hours of CE credit, along with the 7 hours of pain management no later than 12-31-2009.
- Even-numbered licensees will renew their license and attest to completing fifty hours of CE credit no later than 12-31-2010.

Qualified Programs (858-040-0035)

Any formally organized program of learning that contributes directly to your competence to practice, and can be demonstrated as useful to your work is acceptable to the Board.

Examples: Workshops or conference sessions held by professional organizations; University or college courses (including internet courses); Formally organized workplace education programs or Study Groups; Paid supervision or consultation received; Published books or articles; Home Study; Volunteer service as a lecturer or speaker; Office and Time Management, and Practice Management.

Programs that do not Qualify (858-040-0036)

Practice-building courses; Yoga; Marketing; Word processing courses; among others.

Credit Hours Granted (858-040-0055)

Credit hours shall be for actual hours attended. Some limits apply to the number of hours accepted for specific categories.

Evidence of Completion (858-040-0065)

Acceptable documentation includes: Transcript; Certificate of attendance; Study Group syllabus; Copy of book or journal or article title page; and Copy of cancelled check (for paid supervision or consultation). Licensee must retain documentation for two years *after* the reporting period ends.

Hardship (858-040-0015)

The Executive Director may grant exemptions in whole or in part from continuing education requirements, including extension of deadlines, in documented hardship cases.

Random Audit (858-040-0075)

Licensees selected for a random audit will be asked to submit documentation of all continuing education for the preceding 24 months. If the CE report is not approved the applicant shall be notified and given time to correct deficiencies.
