A.) Guarantee required when a source of the nutrient is added or when the feed is a principal source of the nutrient for the animal.

B.) Sodium guarantee required when total sodium exceeds that furnished by the maximum salt guarantee.

C.) Goat / sheep feeds must indicate minimum & maximum Copper in ppm if copper is added, or if total copper exceeds 20 ppm

D.) Rabbit feeds must guarantee crude fiber minimum & maximum percentages - range not to exceed 5.0 units.
