Oregon Johne's Program update

USDA funding has been reduced to 10 percent of 2006 levels. With this limited funding, ODA will offer the following options to Oregon cattle producers.

Johne's subsidized testing (at cost of test materials)

- ☛ Participants must have a current risk assessment and management plan.
- ☛ All test results are confidential.
- ☛ Tests available as follows
 - Blood ELISA: \$2.75 per test
 - Fecal culture: \$10.00 per test
 - Fecal PCR: \$15.00 per test (30 or more samples required for this price)

Risk assessments & management plans

- ☛ Contact your private practitioner or the ODA to conduct a risk assessment and prepare a management plan. This assessment and plan provide an effective means of dealing with Johne's and all other fecal borne diseases.
- ☛ There are over 160 Oregon dairy herds enrolled in the Johne's Management Program.

Johne's status herds

- ☛ There are 20 herds in the Johne's Test Negative Program and more herds are applying.
- ☛ If you want to participate call for a free qualifying test.
