**Oregon  
law prohibits  
all animals, except  
for service animals,  
in grocery stores,  
restaurants, and other food  
establishments.**

**Service animals are working  
animals, NOT pets.**

**The Americans with Disabilities  
Act authorizes the use of service  
animals in a food establishment  
ONLY for the benefit of individuals  
with disabilities.**

"Shopping with Service Animals."**

**SERVICE ANIMALS  
WELCOME**

**People with disabilities may bring service  
animals into all areas where customers are  
normally allowed to go.**

**A service animal is any guide dog, signal  
dog, or other animal trained to provide  
assistance to a person with a disability.\***

**There must be a direct link between the task an animal  
performs and the person with a disability.**
