Natural or impounded lakes and reservoirs, estuaries, bogs or other wetlands	DO NOT apply by air or ground within 200 feet	> 8 acres •60 foot buffer by air •10 foot buffer by ground
Type D & F streams & rivers	DO Not apply by air or ground within 66 feet of point where field surface runoff or stream enters stream	•DO NOT apply by air within 60 feet along entire stream •DO NOT apply by ground within 10 feet along entire stream
Medium & large Type N streams	DO Not apply by air or ground within 66 feet of point where field surface runoff or stream enters stream	No required buffer along entire length of stream but must protect vegetation as required by FPA Implement BMPs
Small Type N streams	If dry: no buffer air or ground If with water: DO Not apply by air or ground within 66 feet of point where field surface runoff or stream enters stream	Protect vegetation as required by FPA Implement BMPs
Where small Type N streams meet other Type N streams		Protect vegetation as required by FPA & Implement BMPs
Where small Type N streams meet Type D or F streams	66 foot buffer at point of entry	60 foot buffer along entire length of stream
